

# **Basic Operations**

Press and hold **Power Button** to turn on the device. It will automatically enter the main menu on **Home** screen after the start-up screen. The main menu includes **Books**, **Music**, **Photos**, **Bookmarks**, **Favorites**, **History**, **File Explorer**, **Settings**, and **User Manual**. Press the function button to enter the desired mode directly.  $\blacksquare$  is displayed on top of the screen when SD card is inserted. Press  $\blacksquare$  to refresh screen display.



# Books

The device supports 16 types of file formats, including PDF, CHM, EPUB, TXT, HTM, HTML, RTF, PDB, DJVU, DJV, iw44, iw4, FB2, PRC, MOBI, and TCR.

# **Book Submenu**

Press the function button to enter **Books** mode. Booklist is displayed (Default Settings). Press 🗲 to return to **Main Menu**.

Press **T** to enter **Books** submenu detailed as follows.

Refresh screen display.

- File list is sorted by display mode.

Press the function button to enter **Favorites** mode. Press **E** to enter submenu. Press **#** to exit **Favorites** submenu.

### 8. Add to Favorites

# Add desired files to My Favorites.

Press the function button to select desired file(s) and press **confirm**  $\checkmark$  to confirm the option. Press the function button again to cancel selection.

# 9. Go to page

Skip to desired page.

- Press the function button to input character(s) and press 
  <sup>ID</sup> to confirm option. Press 
  <sup>ID</sup> to backspace or press 
  <sup>ID</sup> to exit Go to page submenu.
- Press I to toggle input methods. Press the function button to confirm option.

### 10. Search

Search for a desired item.

- Press I to toggle input methods. Press the function button to select input methods.
- Search result will be displayed. Press Page Jump Buttons to turn pages if available. Press the function button to open the desired file. Press New Search to restart search or press Back to exit Search menu.



#### 11. Music

Please refer to Music Mode.

### 12. Return Button 🗲

Press the function button to return to previous option.

# Reading Books

- Booklist is displayed (Default Settings). Press Page Jump Buttons to turn pages. Press the function button to open the desired file.
- 2. During reading, press Page Jump Buttons to turn the page. Press ■ to enter submenu detailed as follows. Press ← to exit submenu.

Refresh	Refresh screen display.
Dictionary	Not available.
View bookmarks	Browser bookmarks if available.
Add bookmark	Press the function button to save the address of the current page.
Music	Please refer to <i>Music Mode</i> for more detail instructions about <b>Music</b> function.
Reflow	Page fits the screen size. It's only available with files in PDF formats.
Go to page	Please refer to <b>Book/9. Go to page</b> for more detail instructions.
Rotate	Screen orientation can be set to vertical/horizontal manually. Press the function button to toggle between the two modes.
Zoom	Press the function button to zoom in/out the contents on screen. 5 zooming circles are available. Press ←/↑/↓/→ to move to the desired part.
Settings	Please refer to <i>Books/Reading Books/3. Settings menu</i> .
Search	Search for a desired character/keyword.
View Contents	The book index information is displayed.



### 3. Settings menu

From the submenu, Press the function button to enter **Settings menu** detailed as follows.

# NOTE:

It's unavailable with files in PDF and DJVU formats.

Font	Set up the current font. Microsoft Yahei, Arial, Courier, Times, and ARIALN are available. Press the function button to confirm option.
Encode	Select corresponding code when random characters are displayed. The function is unavailable with files in PDF and DJVU formats.
Margins	Set up space to the left/right side of the text. 2 margin spacing cycles are available.
Line spacing	Set up space between lines in text.
Hyphenation	Toggle word division between hyphenation and justification.
Bold	Display the characters in bold type.
Italic	Display the characters in italic type.
Book info	Display technical information of the current book.





Press the function button to enter **Music** mode. The playlists is displayed. Music files saved on micro SD card are also displayed in the list. The device supports MP3 (32kbps-384kbps) files format only.

# Music Submenu

Press **I** to enter **Music** submenu detailed as follows. Press to exit **Music** submenu.

My Favorites	Favorite music files are displayed if added. Please refer to <i>Favorites Mode</i> for more detailed instructions.
Add to Favorites	Add the desired music files to <b>My Favorites</b> . Press the function button to select desired file(s) and press <b>confirm</b> $\checkmark$ to confirm the option. Press the function button again to cancel selection.
Go to page	Skip to the desired page. Please refer to <b>Book/9.</b> Go to page for more detail instructions.
Search	Search for a desired item. Please refer to <b>Book/10</b> . <b>Search</b> for more detailed instructions.



# Music Playback

Press the function button to play the desired track. On the playback screen, the following operations can be performed.



- 1. Press ♥/♥ to adjust the volume level.
- 2. Press ◀× to disable the sound. Press it again to resume the sound.
- 3. Press <sup>∞</sup> (Random), <sup>≈</sup> (Loop), and <sup>d</sup> (Repeat Once) to select cycle mode.
- Press ►/II to play/pause the playback. Press ■ to stop playback. Press Page Jump Buttons to skip to previous/next track.
- 5. Press 🗲 to return to Playlists screen.
- Brief information of the file is displayed on the screen.

# **Background Music Mode**

The function allows to read books or view photos while playing a track. During music playback, press  $\leftarrow$  to enter **Background Music Mode**, in which you can use the device with playing music.

To exit the mode, press the function button to enter **Music Mode**, and then press ►II to enter current playback screen. Press ■/II to stop/pause the playback.





# Photos

Press the function button to enter **Photos** mode. Photos saved on SD card are also displayed in the list. The device supports picture formats such as TIFF, JPEG, GIF, BMP, and PNG.

# Photos Submenu

Press **T** to enter **Photos** submenu detailed as follows.

# 1. My Favorites

Press the function button to enter **Favorites Mode**. Press **■** to enter submenu. Press **★** to exit **Favorites** submenu.

## 2. Add to Favorites

Add the desired photo files to My Favorites.

Press the function button to select desired file(s) and press **confirm**  $\checkmark$  to confirm the option. Press the function button again to cancel selection.

#### 3. Go to Page

Skip to the desired page. Please refer to **Book/9.** Go to page for more detailed instructions.

### 4. Search

Search for a desired item. Please refer to **Book/10**. **Search** for more detail instructions.

#### 5. Thumbnails

Display photos by thumbnail. Press **View in List** to display photos by file name.

### 6. Music

Please refer to Music Mode for more detailed instructions.



# Viewing Photos

Press the function button to view file. The following operations can be performed.



- Press Zoom Button to zoom in/out the contents on the screen.
- Press ←/↑/↓/→ to move to the desired part.
- Screen orientation can be set to portrait / landscape manually. Press C to activate the function.



# **Bookmarks**

All bookmarks are displayed on the screen. Numbers/titles/bookmarks are displayed in the list.

#### NOTE:

The function is only available with book(s) containing bookmark(s).

- Press Page Jump Buttons to turn the page. Press to return to the previous option.

#### NOTE:

Please refer to **Book/Book Submenu** for more detailed instructions about the submenu.



# Favorites

All favorite files (books, music, and photos) are displayed. From **Favorites** list, press  $\blacksquare$  to enter the submenu detailed as follows. Press  $\bigstar$  to exit **Favorites** menu.

Delete file(s) from <b>Favorites</b> . Press the function button to select desired book and press <b>confirm</b> ✓ to confirm the option. Press the function button again to cancel selection.
Skip to the desired page. Please refer to <b>Book/9.</b> Go to page for more detailed instructions.
Please refer to <b>Book/10</b> . Search for more detail instructions about Search function.
Please refer to <b>Music Mode</b> for more detailed instructions about <b>Music</b> function.

Press the function button to open a favorite book/music/photo file.





# History

Delete	Delete file(s) from Recent Books list.
Add to Favorites	Add file(s) to Favorites.
Go to page	Skip to the desired page.
Search	Search for an item.
Music	Enter music playlists.

File Explorer

Select a file from **Internal Memory** or **SD Card** and press the function button to enter. All files on flash or SD Card are in the list. Press the function button to open the desired file or press **Page Jump Buttons** to turn pages.

From the **File Explorer** list, press **T** to enter **File Explorer** submenu detailed as follows. Press **4** to exit **File Explorer** submenu.

## 1. Cut

Move a document or file to other file folders.

Press the function button to select desired files and press **confirm**  $\checkmark$  to confirm the option. Press the function button again to cancel selection.

#### 2. Copy

Copy a document or file to other file folders.

Press the function button to select desired files and press **confirm**  $\checkmark$  to confirm the option. Press the function button again to cancel selection.

#### 3. Paste

Paste the files you have removed or copied to a new place. Press the function button to select a place and then press **T** to enter submenu. Press the function button to paste the files you have removed or copied to the current place.

### 4. Delete

Delete current file from flash or SD card.

Press the function button to select desired files and press **confirm**  $\checkmark$  to confirm the option. Press the function button again to cancel selection.



### 5. Add to Favorites

### Add desired files to Favorites.

Press the function button to select desired file(s) and press **confirm**  $\checkmark$  to confirm the option. Press the function button again to cancel selection.

### 6. Go to Page

Skip to the desired page.

#### 7. New Folder

Create a new folder in the current place. Input characters to create a new folder name.

#### 8. Search

Search for a desired item.

#### 9. Music

Enter music play lists. Please refer to **Book/11. Music** for more detailed instructions about the function.





#### Settings

From the main menu, Press the function button to enter **Settings** menu. Press  $\bigstar$  to return to previous option. In the **Settings** menu, the following settings can be performed.

Device Name Set device name.

Select desired language. 19 kinds of languages are available.

Font Type Select the font size.

# Auto Shutdown Settings

Shut down the device to minimize the power consumption of the battery. Select the shut down time and press the function button to activate the function. Available options are **10 minutes**, **20 minutes**, and **30 minutes**. Select **Disable** to disable the function.

Display the technical information of the device.

# • Restore Factory Settings

Press the function button to restore the device to factory default settings. Press  $\leftarrow$  to cancel.

### NOTE:

Files will be deleted permanently once factory default settings are restored.
