## 7.2 Disc Maintenance

#### Holding Discs

Avoid touching the playing surface of discs for it may damage the disc surface.



#### Cleaning Discs

Fingerprints or stain on the disc may affect the quality of sound and picture. Gently wipe the surface of disc by clean soft cloth for cleaning purpose. Moisten a soft cloth with diluted neutral detergent to remove heave dirt or fingerprints if necessary.

Do not wipe in a circular motion (concentric scratches on the disc surface tend to cause noise). Gently wipe from the center of the disc to the outer edge as the right figure.

# 13 Using Straps

Follow the steps below to attach the **Prestigio PPDP 370 Twin** onto the car seat headrest.

- **1**. Place the unit on a soft and smooth surface with the bottom facing up.
- **2.** Loosen up the strap and remove the buckle from the strap.
- **3**. Insert the strap through the hole as demonstrated in Fig.1. Make sure the inner side of the strap faces up.
- **4**. Ease the strap into the buckle as demonstrated in Fig.2 and Fig.3. Before putting the unit onto car seat headrest, please make sure the outer side of the buckle faces up.



- 5. Repeat above steps for the other strap.
- **6**. Adjust the length of the straps to fit the car seat headrest.
- **7**. Fasten the straps on the headrest as in Fig.4. Make sure the two straps are between the headrest supporting metal rods.

**NOTE:** The drawings below illustrate the outside and the inside of the buckles and the straps.
