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
2 Package Contents

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4 System Connection

4.1 Power Connection

- 1. Insert power cable into the power cable socket located on the rear panel of the device.
- 2. Insert the other end of the power cable into a power outlet.

4.2 Monitor Connection

- 1. Insert monitor VGA cable (not included) into VGA Monitor port located on the rear panel of the device.
- 2. Insert the other end of the cable into appropriate VGA port on the monitor.
- 3. Please refer to monitor user manual for more information.

4.3 Printer and Scanner Connection

- 1. Depending on the printer/scanner device, insert cable (not included) into appropriate port located on the rear panel of the device one cable at a time.
- 2. In general, printer device and scanner device are connected with parallel cable and serial cable respectively.
- 3. Please refer to device user manual for more information.

4.4 Network Connection

- 1. Insert RJ-45 network cable (not included) into Ethernet port located on the rear panel of the device.
- 2. Insert the other end of the cable into a 10BastT or 100BaseT port on the network device.
- 3. Green LED indicates valid connection.
- **4.** Please refer to network device manual for more information.

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4.5 Speaker System/Microphone Connection

- 1. It is recommended to power on device before turning on speaker system.
- 2. Insert audio cables (not included) into appropriate audio ports located on the rear panel of the device.
 - Headphone Line-Out Socket (Green) connects to an active stereo or a multi-channel speaker system.
 - Audio Line-In Socket (Blue) connects to an analog audio device.
 - Microphone Socket (Pink) connects to a microphone.
- 3. Please refer to speaker system device manual for more information.

Upon successful completion of connecting components of the device, please follow below instructions to properly power on device:

- 1. Press the power button on the monitor.
- 2. Press the power button located at the front of the device.
- **3.** Follow the on-screen instructions to initiate Microsoft Windows or Linux operation system.
