*Caution: It's recommend that you do not connect the USB Flash Drive to your computer prior to the installation of the driver.* 

- Please insert the driver CD to your CD ROM drive.
- Double click "98Driver" folder.
- Double click "Setup.exe" to initiate the Win98 Driver Setup program and follow the on-screen instructions.
- Click "OK" when the message " installation completed, please replug device in Windows 98 and Windows ME" appears.
- Connect your USB Flash Drive to your computer's USB port.
- Your computer will automatically find the device by displaying "New Hardware Found" message.
- Please check "My Computer." You will see one removable disk icon added.

You have now successfully installed the driver and are ready to enjoy the convenience of USB Flash Drive

## • Windows 2000/ME/XP , Mac & Linux users:

#### For Windows 98/98SE Users:

Feel free to disconnect the device from your computer but only when the LED status indicator light is not blinking.

#### For Windows ME/2000/XP Users:

Warning: The following safe removal procedures must be followed, or data loss might occur.

Please double click the task bar at the bottom of your computer screen. A dialog box will appear. Double click "USB Mass Storage Device" and click "OK." Click "OK" when the message "Safe To Remove Hardware" comes up.

You may now remove it from your computer.

### Mac OS 9.X & 10.X users:

To remove USB Pen drive from your computer, simply drag and drop the disk icon into the trashcan.
